1. **Attendance** – Officers in attendance were Andy Ramsay, Matthew Lytle, Todd Schmitt, and George Costakis.
2. **Approval and review of minutes from last meeting** – Minutes were approved and ratified by a majority vote.
3. **Progress of old business and recap of fall season.** George Costakis has the liquor license forms ready to go; he will just need the dates of the super league matches we will be hosting in order to order the permit. The rental schedule has been put forward by Andy Ramsay and is to be formalized after the holidays. Our fall season was discussed briefly with emphasis on trying to collect dues for last season and making sure we collect for this coming spring season. Matthew Lytle will be moving into the due collecting role for the spring. We need to make sure we find out how much CIPP and PNRFU dues will be. Club dues will remain \$70. We will start trying to collect at our indoor practice sessions.
4. New business:
  - a. **Adopt a Family Event** – Adopt a Family will be coordinated by Peter Thine and will most likely be scheduled some time during the week of the 19<sup>th</sup>.
  - b. **Indoors training** – Indoor training is scheduled for 12/15, 12/29, 1/12, and 1/19. The cost is \$75/hour which is significantly more than it has been in previous years. We will be taking donations at the trainings.
  - c. **Bowl-a-thon** – Our fundraising event is scheduled for 2/19 at Cascade Lanes. Andy Ramsay is taking charge of the event.
  - f. **Boise Trip** – We need to make sure that we get all our key players committed right away. Traveling was a problem for us during the fall and Snake River will probably be one of our biggest challenges. Andy will be providing a minivan to drive down. Another fund raiser was suggested specifically to raise money for this trip.
  - g. **Spring First Side Captain** – Nominations were taken but no captain was decided upon.
  - h. **Spring Coach** – Todd Schmitt will continue acting as our head coach for the spring and will arrange for other coaches to come in and run clinics during regular practice times. We will be advertising with OPSB, Seattle Men's, and PNRFU for a permanent replacement.
  - i. **Roo Raiser** – Scheduled for 4/15 with Pat Galvin as chair. Todd Schmitt will be coordinating with Pat to arrange some details for our next meeting.

j. **Tour** – Fall of 2007 was agreed upon as a realistic goal for our next international tour. Possible locations include Scotland, Ireland, UK, and Bulgaria.
